# ORDINANCE 19-2543 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 223 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD ENTITLED, "PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS"

was introduced at a Work Session Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Council Chambers, Bergenfield Municipal Center, 198 North Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, March 19, 2019 at 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement is to amend Chapter 223 to change the fee schedule for the Summer Park Program to \$175 per person and \$125 for additional members for Residents, and \$350 per person and \$250 for each additional member for Non-residents, as set forth in the ordinance.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 223 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS"

WHEREAS, Chapter 223 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Parks and Playgrounds in the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

#### Chapter 223. Parks and Playgrounds

223-5 entitled Fees and Requirements.

A.Summer Park Program Fee Schedule.

- (1)(a) Residents: \$175 per person; \$125 for each additional family member.
  - (b) Nonresidents: \$350 per person; \$250 for each additional family member.

<u>Severability</u> All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

<u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
